Dear AgriVantage Crop Insurance Client,

As harvest gets underway, we at AgriVantage wish you a safe and productive harvest. Along with that, we have a few reminders as you enter your fields.

SILAGE REMINDER:

Anyone planning to chop silage on more than 50% of any field or unit will need a production estimate of their silage done by an adjuster. You will need a production estimate on your fields. A production estimate is needed for a loss situation and/or for determining unit APH. If you have already started chopping silage, make sure you leave check strips. A representative check strip needs to be at least 10 feet wide and extend the entire length of each field with one additional strip for every 25 acres per field.

If you can, please call AgriVantage approximately 1 week before the start of chopping silage so we can contact an adjuster to get an appraisal made for a production estimate. Advanced notification allows us to contact adjusters and make arrangements that best suit your busy work schedule.

CO-MINGLE/POSSIBLE CLAIM REMINDERS:

****** Remember that any production from prior years in your bin must be measured by a Farmers Mutual Hail representative prior to adding new crop bushels. Please call our office as soon as possible if you plan on co-mingling multiple year production. ******

If you plan on storing multiple production units from 2007 only in one structure (bin), you need to call AgriVantage for co-mingling authorization. **This must be done before you start co-mingling.** When marking bins with co-mingled grain, tape each production unit level and include unit number, field identification, date and initials of the person marking the bin.

Any crop taken to a commercial elevator will need to be weighed separately by unit and a summary and/or a settlement sheet will be needed for verification of delivery amounts.

If you suspect you have a claim, you should report that to us as soon as possible but no later than 15 days after the end of the insurance period (December 10th for most spring planted crops). Printouts from combine monitors are not acceptable as production records for loss purposes but are acceptable to maintain APH records.
